

ENACT meeting summary
September 19, 2006

At this week's ENACT board meeting, the following items were discussed:

1. The Italian Pasta Dinner was a great success. It raised approximately \$1500 through ticket sales and another \$380 through the raffle. Thanks to everyone who helped organize the event, and to everyone who turned out to support ENACT! 2. Rhode Island Housing. Gary Rose has applied for and been tentatively approved for a loan through the ECHO program. He thinks that the staff at Rhode Island Housing are willing to help residents of the Bay Street neighborhood. 3. Property Values and Reassessments. Gail is still trying to get the correct number for the full valuations on the properties in the moratorium area. The last round of information she received from Dave Robert applied the formula for full assessed values incorrectly. She is working on getting a revised list of revaluation amounts, and is hoping to have this information in time for the October 2 filing deadline. 4. Settlement Agreement. Gail has obtained signed copies of the Notice of Violation from RIDEM to Southern Union and the Limited Settlement Agreement between the Attorney General, RIDEM, Southern Union and National Grid. We have heard that the DEM is reviewing work plans for the 6 properties that have imminent hazards, but have no further details to report at this time. Stay tuned for more news and updates.
